Tournament Hole Notes:

	Saturday	Sunday
1	A disc 100% on the path or right of the OB line is OB. Normal Tee, Long Pin all three rounds.	
2	A disc outside the island green is Out of Bounds. All OB shots played from drop zone.	Alternate pin. Same OB, new drop zone. Throw from Drop Zone sign
3	Pin in short position. A disc 100% on the path or left of the OB line is OB.	Pin in long position. A disc on the path or left of the OB line is OB.
4	Mandatory flight path to the right of the marked pole. The creek and beyond is out of bounds. A missed mando or out of bounds tee shot MUST be played from the drop zone.	Basket is in the alternate location. Playing from the same tee as Saturday. Same rules for out of bounds and missed mando shots.
5	The creek and left of the OB line is OB. Short pin location.	Pin is in the alternate location. The creek and left of the OB line is OB.
6	The path and beyond is OB. Drop zone MANDATORY for OB throw from tee.	Basket is in alternative location. Same OB & Drop Zone.
7	Mandatory flight path to the left of the marked pole. A missed mando must be played from the drop zone near the pole. Pin is in original position for 1st round, long for 2nd round.	The pin will be in the far right position. Same mando and drop zone.
8	Short tee pad in play. The parking lot and road is OB. Picnic tables are not OB.	Long tee pad. Mando to left of marked tree. Same OB as Saturday. Drop zone is short tee.
9	Mandatory flight path to the left of the marked tree. Left of string line is OB. A missed mando must be played from the drop zone.	
9B	The creek is OB. The drop zone is mandatory for OB lies.	
10	Tee from the lower tee pad. The path and everything left or beyond the path is OB.	Tee off from the long tee pad. Drop zone is optional for OB from tee.
11	The path and beyond is OB. Pin is in short/normal location	Pin is in the alternate location Same OB
12	All pavement, the curb, and right of the OB line is OB. Beyond the leading edge of the parking lot everything outside of the island in the middle of the parking lot is OB. A drive from the tee that lands OB MUST be played from drop zone. Shots that land OB that were not thrown from the tee can be played using normal OB rules.	

All paved roads, pathways, parking lots and the creek are always out of bounds.

Ties for first place will result in a sudden death playoff on the following holes until the tie is broken: 6, 7, 8 normal tee, 9, 10 from lower tee pad, repeat if necessary.
